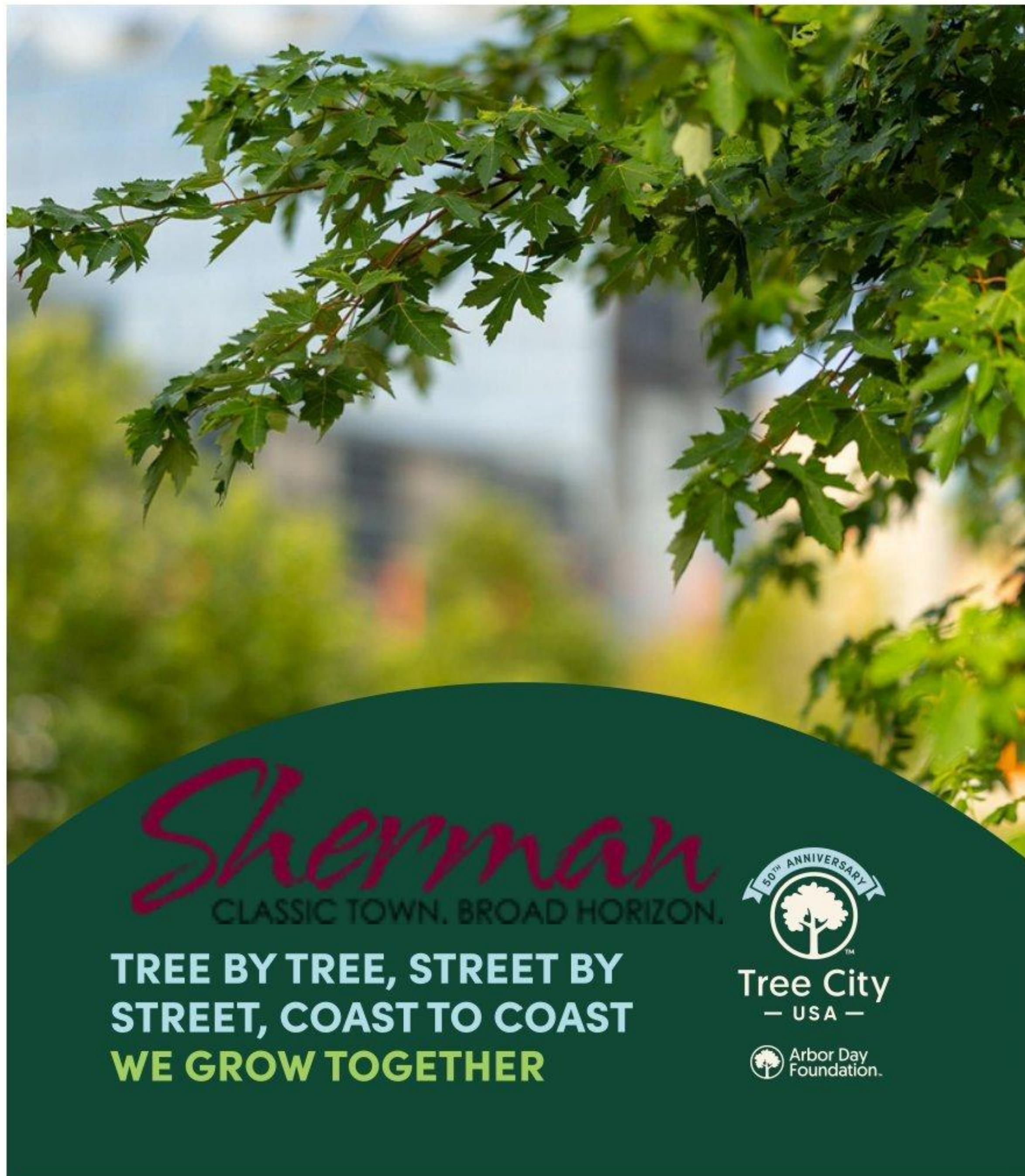
# 2025 Tree City USA Recognition
