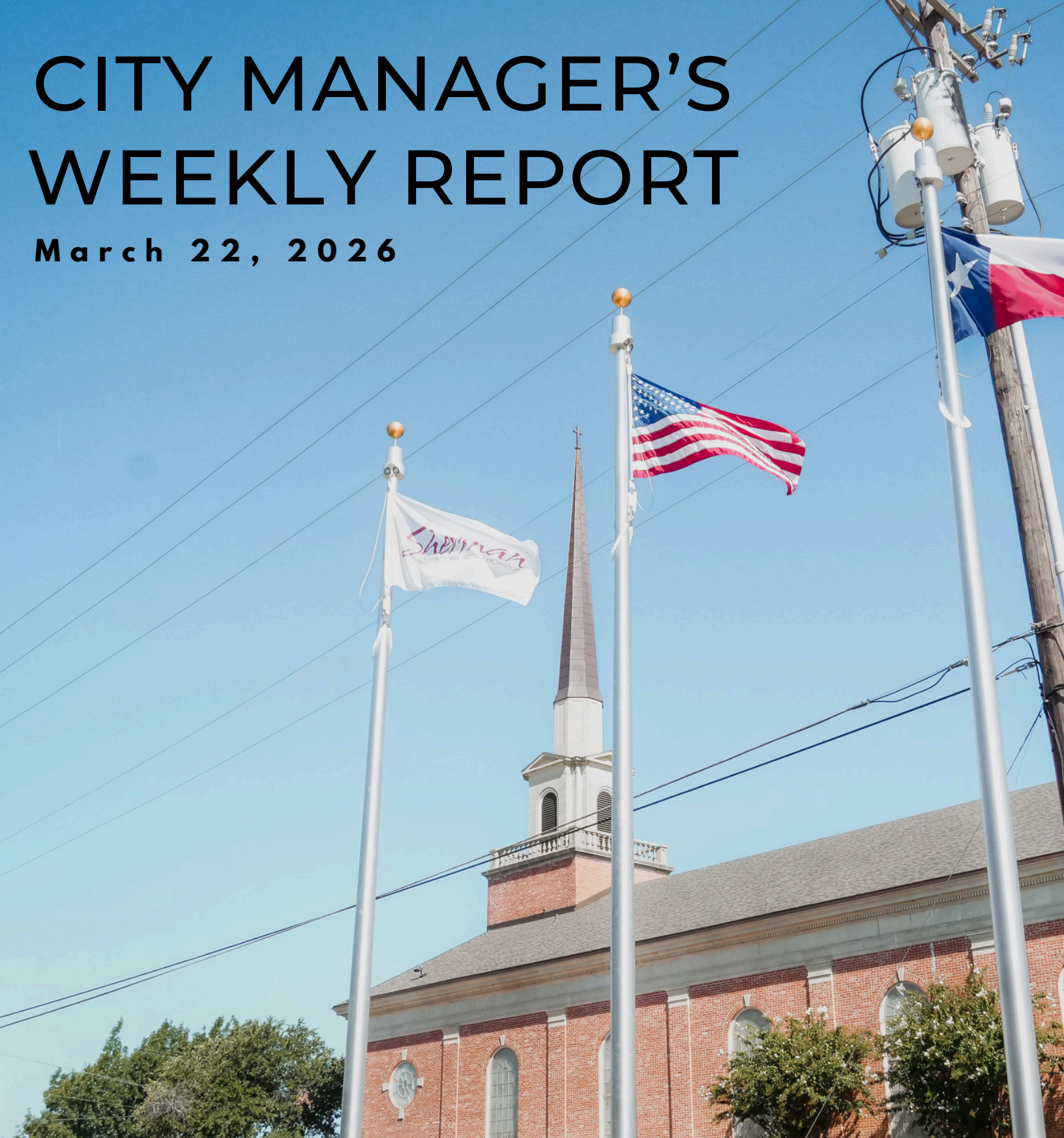

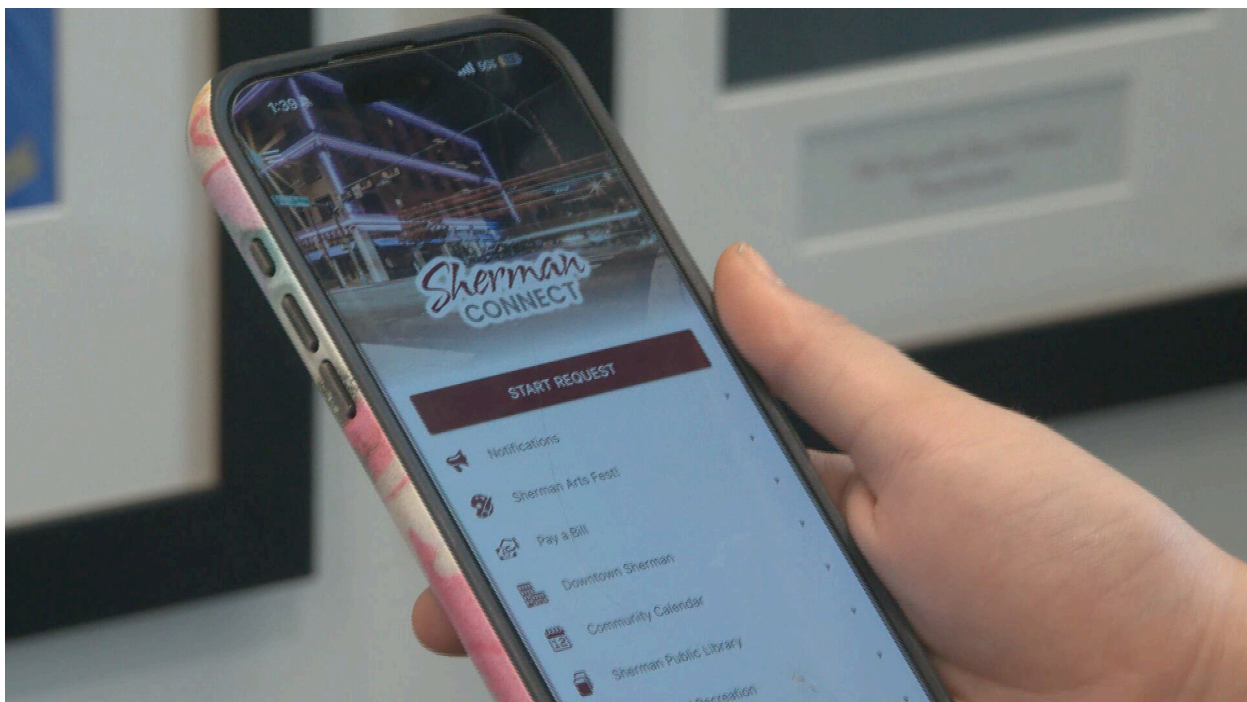
Seasonal New Hires

On-Demand Bulk Trash Program

You can now schedule bulk trash pick-up straight from the Sherman App! In anticipation of the new on-demand bulk trash program launching in May, the ShermanTexas App now allows you to quickly and easily schedule a pick-up from your phone or desktop. The sanitation department should be at your curb within three business days, and you can schedule on free pick up each month.





Facilities Update - Automated Lighting System

Fairview Twilight, Fairview Midway, Fairview Commercial, OSP Fields 1-5, Rosedale, and Fairview Field 6 (Wilkes) have been transitioned to an automated lighting system similar to Musco, allowing staff to set lights remotely at those facilities.

US HWY 75 Construction Update

The following ramps will be closed until the permanent ramps are constructed:

- NB entrance SH91

There are no timeframes at this time on the completion of the permanent ramps.

Street Paving Update

Rosedale area is near completion. We hope to have it completed within next two weeks. After Rosedale is complete, we will be moving to NW Canyon Creek area to begin their paving updates.



Lamberth Road Drainage Improvement Project

- Project is on schedule and 70% complete.
- Culverts have been installed
- Improvements to the bottom of the creek to be completed this week
- Walls are to be completed by mid-week next week
- Remainder of the road to be demoed the following week



Red Cross and Senior Center Collaboration

The Senior Center serves as a designated Red Cross emergency shelter, providing a safe space for our community during times of need. Equipped with cots and other essential accommodations, the Center is prepared to assist individuals and families in the event of a disaster in our community. The Senior Center Coordinator and the City of Sherman Emergency Manager, collaborate in annual planning meetings with the Red Cross, to stay up to date on procedures. Last month the Red Cross successfully conducted an emergency drill at the Center to ensure readiness. As part of our recent remodel, electrical boxes were installed to support a future generator, further strengthening our ability to provide reliable services during power outages.
