CITY UPDATES

US HWY 75 Construction Update

March 8th:

- The northbound main lanes will be closed from Travis St to Loy Lake Rd (Sherman) weather permitting. This overnight closure will include all entrance and exit ramps from the frontage roads to the northbound main lanes. This closure will begin March 8th at 6PM and end March 9th at 5AM.
- **Note:** Northbound traffic will shift to new pavement between Texoma Parkway and US 82. The existing northbound US 82 exit ramp will be closed. The temporary northbound US 82 exit ramp will tentatively open March 9th while the new northbound US 82 exit ramp gets constructed.

March 9th:

- The northbound main lanes will be closed from US 82 to N Loy Lake Rd (Denison) weather permitting. This overnight closure will include all entrance and exit ramps from the frontage roads to the northbound main lanes. This closure will begin March 9th at 6PM and end March 10 at 5AM.
- **Note:** Northbound main lane traffic will shift to the new pavement between US 82 and Spur 503. The existing northbound Loy Lake Rd (Sherman) entrance ramp, existing FM 691 exit ramp, and existing FM 691 entrance ramp will be closed. Weather permitting the contractor has committed to open the temporary FM 691 exit ramp by March 17th.

March 12th:

- The southbound main lanes will be closed from Exit 63 (Town Center) to Travis St weather permitting. This overnight closure will include all entrance and exit ramps from the frontage roads to the southbound main lanes. This closure will begin March 12th at 8PM.
- **Note:** Southbound main lane traffic will shift to the new pavement between Lamberth Rd and Texoma Parkway.

March 15th:

- The southbound main lanes will be closed from Crawford St to Travis St weather permitting. This overnight closure will include all entrance and exit ramps from the frontage roads to the southbound main lanes. This closure will begin March 15th at 6PM.
- **Note:** The existing southbound FM 691 entrance ramp and existing southbound Loy Lake Rd (Sherman) exit ramp will be closed.
